

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Clean and Maintain

- 1. Pat the spills as soon as possible, to avoid liquid/stain to be absorbed into the product.
- 2. If there is visible soil and stain is dry, use a bristle brush to loosen the dirt. Avoid excess pressure.
- 3. Vacuum the surface thoroughly.
- 4. Based on the situation, apply the recommended cleaning solution to a lint free cloth.

 Use a hand spray application, and avoid over-soaking the surface.
- 5. Using the sprayed cloth, pat the stain starting from the outer edge and moving inward.
- 6. If required, get another new cleaning cloth. Repeat procedure until there is no further transfer of the dirt to the cloth.
- 7. Once the stain is removed, soak up all remaining cleaning solution with a dry cloth.
- 8. Use a clean cloth or sponge soaked in water to remove any residue.
- 9. Allow treated surface to air dry.

Disinfect

Proper personal protective equipment must be worn (bleach odor respirator, protective eye wear and gloves).

Solution

- 50/50 solution of warm water and bleach (5.25% sodium hydrochloride solution)
- 3% Hydrogen peroxide
- Distilled water (for stain removal only)
- Aerosol disinfectants, such as Lysol

Steps

- 1. Mix equal amount of bleach and water.
- 2. Mist the surface of the product with a hand spray applicator. Apply generously.
- 3. Allow surface to air dry.

These cleaning and disinfecting instruction meet CDC guidelines.
